Several guests attended to share their work with video production to enhance teaching and learning. J. Thompson showed a video made by students of his honors section of SED 101, Introduction to Exceptionality. Eight groups of three students created videos using Apple equipment. M. Lartz then showed a video she created as a teaching tool for her students in the Deaf and Hard of Hearing program. J. Kurz stated that the video made at U-High was an effort to make the clinical experience at that school better. T. Haynes explained that the full-class videos are being used in C&I 214, but C&I 216 is the class that uses the video made at U-High the most.

K. Fansler explained that most of these videos were made using Apple technology, and at the present time COE has very few of these products. He stated that the Apple representative, Roberta Knapp, will loan equipment to faculty. D. Curtis and K. Fansler attended an Apple conference in California recently and are continuing to examine the options. C. Toledo explained ETIP, Ed Tech Immersion Plus (<http://www.coe.ilstu.edu/etip/>), an initiative to assist faculty in developing technology-enhanced instructional environments.

The presentation was well received. Council members indicated support for the suggestion to conduct a similar presentation open to the Faculty in the College of Education. P. McCluskey-Titus volunteered to coordinate planning with K. Fansler.
